New Adult	Any Adult (born in or before 1998) who has not been a member of the Penetang Curling Club in the last 5 years. Welcome in as many leagues as you are able too and not subject to a sparing fee.	\$400
Learn to Curl	A four week program open to anyone wishing to learn the sport of curling. *Included in Full memebrships	\$100
Sunday Only	A membership for anyone wishing to curl in the Sunday Rec leauge ONLY. ***Members with this membership are subject to the sparing fee if they wish to curl on any other day.	\$250
Intermediate Unlimited	Adults born between 1999-2006. Welcome in as many leagues as you are able to and not subject to a sparing fee.	\$300
